### Home Learning

This week, some children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 have returned to school. However, many children will remain at home. To support these children, I will be creating regular video lessons. These lessons will consist of a presentation, which I will create, and then record myself talking through key learning points. Each 'lesson' will be uploaded to the relevant Google Classroom as well as on our school website, under the tab **Learning** and then **Online Lessons**. As the lessons will be pre-recorded, your child can watch them at a convenient time.

Please bear in mind that this is a new way of teaching and children may need adult support initially to understand how to best access each online lesson. At various points during the lesson, I will prompt the viewer to pause, think and write. Each online lesson will end with a learning challenge for children to do independently. I would then welcome children to share their learning with an adult at home and to upload it to Google Classroom if they wish to share it with their classmates and teachers.

Throughout school closure, both teachers and teaching assistants have been interacting with children, who have posted learning on Google Classroom. This will continue until the end of term. However, please bear in mind that because more staff are in school teaching, children may have to wait a little longer for a response. Every two weeks, teachers will continue to upload a number of home learning resources as well as adding regular challenges throughout the week linked to various aspects of the curriculum. In addition, whenever possible, Mr Wilson, Miss Swain and Mr Young will upload activities, which children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 have completed in school, for children in those year groups, who are not in school, to access at home.

You may be concerned that your child is falling behind in their learning. Please try not to worry. We are in unprecedented times and all children are in exactly the same situation. Over the past few weeks, we have been so impressed with what the children have shared on Google Classroom: baking cakes; gardening; writing stories; researching animals; creating amazing pieces of art work; continuing to work on mathematics; joining in with daily phonics - the list goes on and on. The most important thing for us is that you are all safe and happy. When all children return to school, we will pick up where we left off.
