Dear Parents/Carers,

This week, we will welcome children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 back to school. As part of our risk assessment, we have considered how best to provide the children with reading books in a safe manner. This letter outlines the processes, which we have put in place, to minimise risk.

Reception and Year 1

Children in Reception and Year 1 will come home with a library book on their first day, and their reading scheme books on their second day. Reading scheme books will stay in school so they can read them on their second day in school. At the end of their second day, the children will bring the books home. We would like to challenge the children to read each book three times to improve their word recognition and understanding of the stories. When they return all of their books on day one each week, there will be a box just inside their entrance, in which to put the books. Following guidance from the School Library Service, these books will be left alone for 72 hours before being returned to the shelves by staff. Please continue to record reading in your child's reading record but **we do not want reading records brought into school each day.**

Year 6

Children in Year 6 will pick a reading book on their first day in school each week. This book will stay in school so they can read it on their second day in school. At the end of their second day, the children will be able to bring the book home. We would like to challenge the children to finish the book before they return to school the following week. When they return the book, there will be a box just inside their entrance, in which to put the book. Following guidance from the School Library Service, these books will be left alone for 72 hours before being returned to the shelves by staff. If the reading book is not finished, please keep it at home. Please continue to record reading in your child's reading record but **we do not want reading records brought into school each day.**

Miss Cleveland has worked tirelessly to continue to provide the children with many reading opportunities. She will be ensuring the children have a lovely selection of books available in their classrooms, which will be shared by teachers.
