 <p>Christmas Dinner</p>	<p>Bookings are still being taken for <b>Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> December</b> - you have until Monday 6.12.21 - 9am to book a dinner.</p>
<p>Carols Around the Tree</p> 	<p>This will be a virtual show of each year groups performance. The children will be shown this on <b>Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> December</b>, and it will be available on the school website on the same day.</p>
<p>Father Christmas</p> 	<p>Father Christmas will visit the children and hand out presents, with a little help from the school.</p>
<p>Christmas Games/Party</p> 	<p>This year, Christmas parties will be held separately in each class. You will be notified of the date for each year group in the school Newsletter.</p>
<p>Last Day of Term</p> 	<p>On the last day of term, <b>Friday 17<sup>th</sup> December</b>, the children will be able to come into school in non-uniform and enjoy a Christmas Movie! The children will not be able to bring their toys in from home, but they will have plenty of time to enjoy the last day!</p>
