Please could you ensure you add in ingredients information if cakes are homemade as we have some children and adults with specific dietary needs.

All stalls will be priced at either 50p or £1. Flag colouring and sporty games will be free-of-charge. We recommend that children bring change in multiples of 50p in a named wallet/purse/money-bag.

We appreciate that not every parent will be able to attend the event. Please do not worry as all school staff will be outside to ensure the children are safe and enjoying themselves. If you are unable to attend the event, you are welcome to send some picnic food in with your child to enjoy in the afternoon.
